RUSINGA ISLAND DIALOG

During our visit we had opportunity to minister to the children and the volunteer teachers that are doing so much to be a blessing to the less fortunate.

One of the highlights of our dialogue sessions here on the island was to see numerous woman in ministry not only to support. But function is pastors in the community.

Although the Dialog in Awendo did not achieve the desired objective due to low turn out of leaders, we were able to minister to the school teachers and all of sum 500 students.

The Children were such a great blessings and Welma and I had opportunity to have individual sessions with many children, just to encourage them and pray with them.

There is such a need for Missionaries to invest time, talent and treasure in these schools and orphanages and help uplift the spirit of these kids, the teachers and the local community as a whole.
